





New for BIO Asia-Taiwan: Exhibitor Booth Partnering

- Deadline: July 5
- Exhibitors this year may opt-in to have their meetings prioritized to be scheduled at their exhibit booth(s)
- Any meetings that cannot fit (due to location or calendar availability) will be scheduled in the general partnering area or virtually, depending on the attendance types of the meeting participants
- BIO recommends no more than 1 meeting point per 100 sq ft (approx. 9 sq. meters) of your exhibit space
- Exhibitors are responsible for their meeting point signage





5 Key Steps for using the Partnering System

- 1. Create/update your company and personal profile
- 2. Select your availability for partnering meetings on your Calendar
- **3. Send meeting requests** use the Search to narrow down best opportunities
- 4. Respond to all incoming meeting requests in the Message Center
- 5. BIO will schedule your accepted meetings, but keep a **lookout for** meetings that can't be scheduled due to lack of mutual availability

Partnering Best Practices

Prepare your profile

Add as much information as possible to help other companies find you, so you can get the right requests. Add assets, services, market products when applicable. Select specific TAs and MOAs.

Start requesting meetings early

Begin 4+ weeks before BIO Asia-Taiwan to allow others time to respond. Target the most relevant prospects by using Advanced Search filters.

Make your subject count


Meeting request subject lines should be tailored to the target company.

Target your meeting request

Provide specific benefits of partnering with your company.

Follow up

Getting close to the conference but no response? Write a "reply only" message to the company. Respond to all incoming requests.




Sending a meeting request with the subject line "meeting request" is no different than sending an email with the subject line "email."



Quick Partnering System User Tips


- Complete your company profile using specific, targeted fields like TAs, objectives, descriptions - The brief description appears in search results page and is a great way to introduce your company and objectives!
- Use the Advanced Search to target specific therapeutic areas & indications and isolate new companies since your last search
- Review your target's company profile then send tailored & targeted meeting requests (TAs, portfolio fit, efficacy, safety, market assessment)
- Respond to all incoming meeting requests accept or decline to keep your Message Center up-to-date
- Update your notifications settings to ensure you're receiving the messages you want from us
